Policy Guidelines (2024)

Public Second Cycle Institutions have been categorized into four(4) groups namely;

Category A: Overly subscribed Schools

Category B: Averagely subscribed Schools

Category C: Under Subscribed Schools

Category D: All Catchment Area Day Schools

- Choice of schools across regions is permitted.

SELECTION GUIDELINES

Please note that candidates:

- Cannot choose more than one (1) School from Category A
- Cannot select more than two (2) schools from Category B
- May select five (5) schools from Category C and One (1) from Category D (Day) or Appendix 3 (Special Boarding)
- Candidates who wish to offer purely TVET <u>Programmes</u> must select all six (6) TVET Institutes from CATEGORY A, B and C as **Day** or

SELECTION GUIDELINES

Cluster Choices

- d) Select 5 schools (1 category A, 2 category B and at least 2 Category C) from appendix "4" for a consideration of 2nd placement if not placed in any of the six (6) main choices.
- e) Schools in the main choices must not be repeated in the cluster
- e) Candidates who wish to offer purely TVET <u>Programmes</u> can select all choices from TVET Institutions in CATEGORY A, B and C as **Day** or **Boarding**
- f) Lastly, candidates who wish to offer programme choice in relation to future job prospects such as Engineers. Physicians, Astronauts, etc. must, select STEM/science in all Six(6) choices from category A, B, C as Day or Boarding

Selection Criteria

Candidates who wish to enter SHS/TVET schools must, with guidance from parents/guardians and school authorities:

- Select Six (6) schools and rank them in order of preference with the first being the most preferred choice (main choices)
- Select <u>Programmes</u> and <u>Residential</u> preferences for each choice of school.
- c) Select a compulsory Day school as the 6th choice within 16km of the JHS attended or choose a boarding school from the list of schools in Appendix 3(Special Boarding)

Mode of selection of schools (cont.)

- Private Candidates must select their school choices online via; https://www.waecinternetsolution.org
- Date for the selection would be announced when the portal is ready
- Foreign Students must purchase foreign students
 application form, fill and submit to the Director for
 schools & Instructions at the GES headquarters, Accra.

Mode of selection of schools

- BECE Candidates are supposed to select six(6) 2nd cycle schools of their choice for placement.
- Mode of selection of the schools differ in terms of Categories of Candidates
- School Candidates Select their schools and forward them to their districts Education Offices through their JHS Heads

30% Public JHS Allocation

30% of the total vacancies declared by each of the Category
'A' schools are reserved for candidates from the Public Basic
Schools (JHS)

Implying that 30% of the total vacancies declared by all
Category 'A' schools is set aside for Public Basic Schools
(JHS) candidates who have selected that particular Category
'A' school
